DESCRIPTION:

GraceStation Foundation is accepting applications for undergraduate local scholarship for the year 2024.

1. ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP:

The Gsf scholarship is a support scheme designed for academically exceptional yet financially disadvantaged tertiary students pursuing programs in Science, Technology, Engineering, Economics, Mathematics, and Agriculture in Ghanaian public Universities.

This year the scheme is targeting to award a total of 80 scholarships to deserving students and this come in the form of:

- Full Tuition & Hostel Scholarship
- Full Tuition & Half Hostel Scholarship
- Full Tuition Scholarship
- Half Tuition Scholarship

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a Ghanaian.
- Be able to demonstrate financial need.
- Obtained a WASSCE aggregate of 19 or better.
- Continuing student must obtain a CGPA of 3.0 or a CWA of 60 and above.
- Be of good conduct (i.e., not have any past or pending disciplinary action taken against him/her).
- Studying 'STEAME' – Science, Technology, Engineering, Agriculture, Mathematics and Economics undergraduate program.
- Must be a regular student in a public university.

Note: Nursing Training Colleges and Colleges of Education are not eligible.

3. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

The following are required documents needed by first-time applicants:

Academics: High School Graduates

- High School Transcripts /Terminal reports.
- West African Senior School Certificate Exam Results.
- Proof of university application.
- Records on achievement tests, academic awards, honors, or substantive assessments by teachers, including letters of recommendation.

Academics: Continuing Students

- University Introductory letter.
- University transcript.
- University admission letter and student ID card.
- Recent school fee's structure and Hostel bill.
- Previous school and hostel fees receipts.
- Records on achievement tests, academic awards, honors, or substantive assessments by teachers, including letters of recommendation.

- All applications must be done online (www.Gracestationfoundation.org)
 - Submission of hard copies of application would be rejected.
 - Applicants with any form of disability are required to upload medical certificates stating the level of seriousness of disability.
 - Applicants who enjoy any form of educational scholarship should not apply.
- It is important that your eligibility for the scholarship award is based on the provision of accurate information. Misrepresentation in any material renders the application null and void. Any award made based on misrepresentation shall be withdrawn and if any investments are made based on misrepresentation, the applicants shall refund all monies paid to him/her or may face prosecution or both.
- Both successful and non-successful applicants will be notified by email 2 weeks after the deadline.

IMPORTANT DATES/DEADLINES

- Expression of interest- this is when applicants fill in the first online application form on our website to express their interest for the scholarship after careful consideration of their eligibility state. **3rd to 23rd June 2024.**
- Main application form – During this phase successful applicants are requested to fill in a comprehensive application form and send through all supporting documents via email. **15th to 31st July 2024.**
- Virtual interview session- a virtual interview is conducted with successful applicants from the 2nd stage for further assessment of their eligibility. **12th to 16th August 2024.**
- In-person Interview – Success applicants are invited to GraceStation premises for an in-person interaction for final confirmation of scholarship type to be awarded. **19th to 30th August 2024.**
- Agreement signing – this is the final stage of the scholarship process where both parties append their signature to the terms and conditions of the scholarship scheme. **2nd to 6th September 2024.**
